 - Amended and Restated Bylaws approved by VHCL Board 6-0 on 9/6/2020
 - Summary of Changes
 - Directors changed from 7 to 5
 - Term changed from 1-Year to Two-year term
 - Required meetings changed from 2/year to 1/year
 - Discussion to have Evershed Attorneys look at VHCA transferring to 501c3 by Jenifer and David for next term if re-elected.
 - Redlines shared via email, pre-meeting
 - David motions to support changes Josh seconds passes 11-0
- Street Renaming Initiative Discussion Chip Franzoni
