Elected Public Officials & Municipal Representatives -

- City Councilman District 6 Alex Wan
 - Switching out his committee assignments. Will be Finance Exec Chair, Transportation Committee - will work on 2015 and 2021 transportation infrastructure projects and park improvements
 - New Transportation commissioner getting introduced. Alex sharing the 6 local projects with him for immediate involvement
 - Alcohol Code Reform finishing up their recommendations. Savi Provisions is an applicant for the Caldwell Banker location on North Highland. Will be coming through NPU next month.
 - Public Safety focus of the city. Retention, hiring, staffing is main focus. Offered a challenge grant for funding for license plate readers for the neighborhood.
 - Appreciates the VHCA effort with Atlanta Botanical Gardens. Tough situation but has been constructive & collaborative effort. Zoning loophole that caused the situation needs to be looked at so we can fix for future.

Social Services recommendation - Zaban Paradies Center insights - Adrianne Hamilton-Butler, ED of Zaban Paradies Center (20-30min) -

- Zaban has been around for 30 years. 1 of 2 in nation that allow couples to stay together.
 Serve couples as they present. Married/not/gay/straight/... 1 of 2 agencies that do diversion work. Go into encampments, parks, etc. Help candidates that can use short term housing. Will help buy subsidized / rapid rehousing. Have a day program.
- Adrianne's suggestions when interacting with homeless people: Be as kind as possible.
 Discourage talking to people in the parks. Might cause consequences that are unexpected. Discourage giving money, food, water. Offer them a place where they can call. Tell them where the resources are.
- Atlanta homeless population (PIT count January 2020 3,740. 2021 2,400)
- 40% of all single family home sales corporate investors driving up cost of housing.
- Opportunities for us
 - Partners for Home Atlanta Continuum of care oversees agencies like Zaban.
 Consider partnering with them to have our voice heard. Dispatch to the works.
 To build relationships with the homeless population. www.partnersforhome.org
 housed 800 homeless folks in 2021. Goal this year is 1500.
 - Call 311 PAD policing alternative to diversion. Way to get involved without involving the police.7am - 7pm
 - Call Georgia Crisis for Mental Health 800-715-4225
 - Gateway Center coordinated entry. Primary place to get routed for housing.
 404-215-6600 (adults)
 - Servies Youth, Ages 18-24 Cris180 407-346-2693 can provide assistance (based in Dekalb county) - have mobile people
 - Create cards with the resources to handout to local residents and businesses.

- Residential Variance request Planning Committee
 - V-22-187; 770 Ponce de Leon Terrace (R-4/BL); north side of Ponce Terrace., about 150 yards east (toward Barnett) of Ponce de Leon Place Allison and Jamie DelMedico working with Mark Arnold, architect asking for a variance for new construction: sideyard setback, westside reduction of setback to add carriage house/accessory structure (from 7ft to 3ft). 6 neighbors have been informed. Planning committee visited the site, . Large trees in the footprint. approved
 - Friends of Orme Park working to get invasive species removed. Would like to work with VHCA, Park Pride, Trees Atlanta to share the narrative.
- Portman presentation for Ponce on Ponce Planning Committee
 - Proposed East Parcel: 354 residential apartments (10% affordable housing make 60% of average median income), office space, retail West Parcel: office and retail (2000 studio, 1B/1B \$2500, 2B/2B \$3560
 - Portman team and Chip Bullock reviewed site plans and renderings. Working very closely with the neighborhood to ensure partnership in decisions including street access, beltline access, Maiden Lane & Ponce Place traffic impact
