#### **Guests & Elected Officials**

Atlanta Police Department - Sergeant Johnson -Provided the report for the month of May - 5 crimes against persons (1 fondling, 3 simple assaults), 34 crimes against property (17 theft from motor vehicles, 3 burglaries, 6 damage to property), 0 crimes against society. Citywide trend targeting Kia's and Hyundai's - invest in steering wheel club, Take key fobs into your house if you have an electric starting vehicle/electric key. You can buy a Faraday bag which blocks the signal of the key to the car.

    - priorities are Transportation and Unemployment
- District 4 Fulton County Commissioner Natalie Hall Mr. Harris joined meeting on behalf of Commissioner Hall. Provided an update.
  - Presentation of key highlights of Fulton County and General Assembly occurred recently. Fulton County Commissioner has been advocating for a Mental Health



program to support the City of Atlanta. It was agreed upon and COA was appointed \$6.5MM to start the project. Will be meeting with Health & Human Services this week. With Atlanta Medical closing, Grady is the only Level 1 hospital in the City of Atlanta.

- Board of Commissioners are meeting this Wednesday. Will be doing a mid-year budget review. Will include funding request for Special Election on May 8th.
- Their office is available to assist our neighborhood with the following: (1) Community Cleanups, (2) Ensuring families get fed / food availability, (3) Youth needing employment during the summer. Contact Mr. Harris for information

## **Planning Variances**

- Variance 1 House on Park Drive 664 Park Drive Nina Gentry (Gentry Planning Services), Ben Kundhi (homeowner), existing house that was demolished. Approved for construction.
  Remaining 1 story garage and existing pool. Recommendation made to approve the proposal for a 2nd story and moving of structure by 3 feet. Unanimous vote to approve by entire board
- Variance 2 and Special Exception Melissa Gamble request to build a pool at corner of Virginia Circle and Barnett - adjacent to the street. Variance requires depth setback from 17 to 16 feet. Reduction of rear setback from 15' to 2.5 '. Have talked to neighbors. Rear neighbors agreed to it as both neighbors on either side. Recommendation for approval - board all approved yes. Passes 9 - 0

## **Officer & Committee Updates**

- Budget Jess / Leah Review Treasurer's Report
  - Concert for JHP raised at least \$3,763.77! Awaiting a refund from A1. Amount above expenses will be transferred to VHCL.
  - For JHP renovation, the invoice on Frawley's work around the playground equipment scoping and stormwater retention coordination was forwarded to VHCL to pay.
  - Budget v Actual through March 31 was distributed to board and will be posted to vahi.org on the Budget Committee page <u>https://vahi.org/committees/financials/</u>
  - SF costs are coming in for marketing (Andi) and sponsorship work (Rick) while income is coming in from the 5k registrations which are outpacing even 2017, which drew over a thousand runners! (\$2,555 deposited so far for 5k March and April deposits)
  - YTD Income minus expenses is -\$12,695.01 as of March 31
  - Discussion around help with sponsorships consider hiring consultant to assist across all fundraisers
- Transportation & Safety Johnson & Amy proposal to Alex Wan's office that was reviewed in last meeting. Hoping to report an update next month.

- Education Melissa & Lisl there will be no rezoning for the upcoming year. There is residency review occurring now for Midtown High. If you have a Kindergartner, registration is open now for Springdale Park and Virginia Highland elementary
- Fundraising/Event Leah -
