Approval of Minutes from prior month's Board meeting - Leah - approved

Guests & Elected Officials

Atlanta Police Department - Sergeant Johnson

Last 30 day report - 6 crimes property (4 motor vehicle theft), impersonation.

Biggest concern/recommendation: Don't leave valuables in your vehicle. If you must, store them in your trunk. Don't leave spare keys/key fobs in vehicle.

Targeting Kias and Hyundai vehicles. Take all measures to secure/guard property. Purchase steering wheel club is recommended. Giving away for free at Zone 6 precinct - 2025 Hosea Williams Drive - provide home address and name.

Asked for APD representative in the August Town Hall. Will follow-up.

Elected Public Officials & Municipal Representatives -

- City Councilman District 6 Alex Wan
 - Just passed City's budget, largest in city's history.
 - Key Points: increase in parks \$16MM yearly. Designated towards maintenance and capital improvements incl security incl lights and cameras.
 - \$7MM decrease in transportation. Found another \$12MM approved for new paving and resurfacing of streets. (\$1mm per district)
 - Monroe Drive is next big project for Alex. Scheduled to start 10th/Monroe intersection this fall - possibly September. Will include the southern end of Monroe to Ponce.
 - Able to get funding for staffing in Violations/ APD permits/inspections/alcohol licenses. Working with ATAG to do some reform work. Making recos to the City this summer incl alcohol licenses.

Field of Dreams Pool Proposal - John Closs

- John presented initial presentation incl Site Plan. He has lived in neighborhood last 7 years.
- Vahipool.org, email address, email newsletter
- APS currently owns the land. They can lease the land to a non-profit to build and develop the pool and manage it. Garden Hills, Piedmont Park and Chastain all operate in this manner. 55 of APS's properties are excess. They sold 16 and kept the remainder in a hold bucket. Open to co-developing with the neighborhood. No formal proposal has been given to APS. One pool across APS at MLK center.
- Shared current site plan done by local landscape architect including covered pool during winter months. 10 lanes of swimming. Lessons, Swim team, swim meets (5-6 per year), pool house incl locker rooms. 2 stories incl meeting rooms, garden space. Could tuck in Pickleball courts. Bus loop to handle APS buses. 3 parking spots.
- Could use VHE parking lot during summer. In talks with APS.
- Working through conversations with GA Power and VH church to address the parking situation
- Around same shape and size as Garden Hills pool.
- Sell memberships. Mix of members and non-member hours.
- Goal get it out into community and get feedback incl design.
- Next step start to apply pressure/advocacy to APS to confirm their lease of the land
- Open questions from meeting attendees:
 - parking is biggest question/concern. Raised concerns about need for parking for new soccer
 - Funding: foundations and private organizations is top funding source idea.
 Memberships would be 2nd funding source. Lake Claire & Inman Park charge an upfront \$3K capital investment.
 - Estimate \$5MM to build the facility.

Planning - Zoning Code Variances

- The Dirty Tea: Rita & Brittany Campos opening afternoon tea lounge on St. Charles.
 The Dirty Tea. Been in ATL for 7 years. Waiting on permits from City incl alcohol martinis, champagnes, Not advertising itself as a bar. High tea experience and cocktails.
 55 capacity, requiring 4 spaces. In the old Ten Thousand Villages space. Donna Matthews helping them with the permitting.
 - No decision to be made today. Be prepared to vote in upcoming meeting. They
 need to get the right allocation of parking spots in the Neighborhood
 Commercial District (NC-12)
 - Expecting an August opening. Hours: Mon/tue closed, wed-sat 11-7, sun 12-6
 - Are making valet parking available at the church
 - Will let the NPU know the confirmation of the 4 parking spots before a decision will come before the board.
 - Motion to approve via email once parking details are shared. 7-0 approved.
- 885 Highland Terrace reduce sideyard setback to 1ft vs 3ft. Planning committee is recommending against it.
 - Recommend motion to deny approval 7-0 to recommend to deny
